Missionary Aviation Educational Associate Application

Definition and Eligibility for Missionary Aviation Educational Associate Status:

A "Missionary Aviation Educational Associate" is an organization that recruits and trains individuals in aviation piloting and/or mechanics in preparation for missionary service. A Missionary Aviation Educational organization which is eligible for Associate status with Christian Aviation Ministries must be involved in aviation missions and be an incorporated non-profit organization with: (1) a board of directors; (2) a mission statement; and (3) agree with the Statement of Belief of Christian Aviation ministries.

Associate responsibilities:

1. To fulfill its role as stated above.
2. To complete and return this Application Form with the requested documents; to execute an Agreement of Participation in Christian Aviation Ministries; and to pay a one-time participation Fee.
3. To maintain communication with its missionaries for purposes of accountability in the areas of spiritual growth, professional activity and financial support.
4. To provide annual and other reports as requested by Christian Aviation Ministries regarding the Associate's Christian Aviation Ministries supported missionaries.
5. To collaborate with Christian Aviation Ministries in fundraising activities managed by Christian Aviation Ministries. (The nature of such collaboration to be controlled by the Associate.)
6. To raise awareness among its candidates and potential candidates of availability of Christian Aviation Ministries' scholarships and loan repayment grants.
